Weekly Reading Tasks	Weekly Phonics Tasks
Monday- https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/api/interactives/12954.html Pick your Queen! A great book with lots of discussion. Read this with your Mum/Dad Your choose which Queen ?	Monday- Choose letters that make words that can be read phonetically. Write the letters in chalk on the ground outside. Give your child a word and they must spell it by jumping from letter to letter. This could also be done on paper inside the house.
Tuesday- Look at the index. Can you remember any facts from yesterday reading	Tuesday- Your child could visit this interactive game and play Sentence Substitution .
Wednesday- Use google to find out facts about our queen Elizabeth II. Find her family and make a family tree.	Wednesday- Describe the Queen are there any words to say how she looks?

Friday- What would you like to ask the Queen? Write your questions? Mm/Dad/Teacher could pretend to be the queen! Ask them your questions.	Friday- There are live phonics lessons on Youtube daily. Click here to watch and join in.
Weekly Writing Tasks	Weekly Maths Tasks- Adding
Monday- Once you have read the book. Write five sentences about each queen. Use the book to help you.	Monday- Encourage your child to write all of the number facts up to 20 e.g. $3 + 17 = 20$, $17 + 3 = 20$. Can they use these to write the inverse e.g. $20 - 3 = 17$.
Tuesday- Whose childhood was better? Write about your childhood what do you like? Who do you like? What are your hobbies? What do you learn at school?	Tuesday- Give your child a number between 1 and 20 and ask them to think about how many ways they could make the number using addition.
Wednesday- Would you like to be Queen/King? What would you change if you could? https://www.twinkl.co.uk/resource/t-t-2546367-if-i-were-queen-or-king-for-a-day-activity-sheet	Wednesday- Use your Numbots login to carry on with your robot building.
Thursday- Did you find the information interesting? Write an interesting one.	Thursday- Get your child to write one of the number bonds to or within 10 - e.g. $2 + 8 = 10$ or $3 + 4 = 7$. Can they use these facts to find out the addition facts up to 100? E.g. $20 + 80 = 100$ and $30 + 40 = 70$.
